The committee met Thursday morning, Oct. 3, mainly to discuss handbook revisions and to exchange ideas for next year's presentations. Several ideas were expressed:

She also submitted them to the chair of the MLA website. Peggy also planned to submit handbook revisions (approved by Rob and Shannon) for the CITCI description to Alice Ruleman (Bylaws & Handbook Committee Chair).

No one had yet expressed an interest in being Recorder for the next year, but Peggy planned to send another request to the MLA listserv after the conference.

Ideas were also discussed for events to be hosted by the CI. Grants are available, but the application deadline is Nov. 1. Ideas:
